The Baka Pygmies live in the rainforests of Cameroon, Gabon and Congo. They are traditionally a nomadic people. Within the Pygmy culture, hunting, gathering and fishing are the most important activities. The men hunt animals like antelopes, collect termites and caterpillars and gather food like yams, fruit, mushrooms and vegetables. The women go fishing in the dry season when the water level is low. The Baka Pygmies live in huts called “mongulu”. The women build these small domed houses made of branches and leaves. The Baka Pygmies have a very rich cultural heritage. Music plays a very important role in their lives. Music and dance accompany all Baka activities. But today the Baka Pygmy traditional lifestyle is threatened by massive deforestation. The Pygmies are forced to settle in one place because the destruction of the forest deprives them of their natural resources. But they are very unhappy when they cannot move around. If the authorities don’t save the rainforests, the Pygmies will have to leave their homelands. Their unique culture will disappear forever.
