It is located in the South West Region of Cameroon, near the Gulf of Guinea. It is one of Africa's largest Mountains and volcanoes. It rises to 4100 metres above sea level and it is recorded as the highest point in the whole of West and Central Africa.

latest volcanic activity on the mountain occurred on the third of February, 2012. The mountain is one of Africa's largest volcanoes.

The first written account of volcanic activity could be the one from the Cathaginian Hanno The Navigator, who might have observed it in the fifth century BC. He thus named it "The Chariots of the Gods." Explosive eruptions have occurred throughout history. A 1992 eruption of the Mountain produced a lava flow that reached the Atlantic Coast.

Also, a lava flow from 1999 stopped only 200metres from the sea. This actually cut off the coastal highway.

There are many activities that are being carried out on Mount Cameroon throughout the year. Some of these include hunting, farming, tourism, the Mount Cameroon Race of Hope.
