The shuttle Discovery and its astronauts returned safely to earth on Tuesday after making a rare flyover of America's heartland to wrap up their 15-day, 6 million-mile journey to the International Space Station.

The touchdown was delayed by rain and fog that dissipated as the sun rose. Commander Alan Poindexter made what appeared to be a smooth touchdown, a day late because of the rain. Discovery scooped through a hazy sky before landing on the Kennedy Space Center runway. This was, in fact, Discovery's next-to-last flight. Only one more mission remained for NASA's oldest surviving shuttle. As soon as it was removed from the runway, it was prepared for the final flight, scheduled for November 2010. It was the first time since 2007 that a space shuttle has descended over so much of the United States.

Meanwhile, history made with the presence of four women in space on 2 April 2010. One of the women was a former teacher, two were space engineers and one was Japanese. It was a wonderful experience for **them**.

Scientists, researchers, and space engineers, who have worked on space programmes over the years, have had to meet some challenges that space travel presents. Space has no air and temperatures on earth are not comparable to those in space. Also, the sun is a source of dangerous radiation which could put the lives of astronauts at risk. To meet some of these challenges, engineers have built filters on spacecraft windows to protect astronauts from binding ultraviolet rays. They have also equipped the spacecraft with the thermal control system that regulates temperatures to make it conducive to living comfortably.
