EMERGENCY SERVICE

Emergency medical services treat illnesses and injuries that require an urgent medical response. In an emergency, people contact the emergency services by phoning a special number for example 999 or 112. This put them in contact with services such as ambulances, paramedics, the police or the fire brigade out of hospital treatment and transportation in hospitals. They give the first response to calls for help.

Hospital have Emergency Rooms (E.R.) and Emergency Wards (EW) where patients are given urgent attention. These facilities provides initial treatment for a wide spectrum of illness and injuries that require immediately medical care. People with severe injuries and trauma are taken there for emergency treatment.
