Many things can be done by individuals and the community as a whole to fight microbes and many diseases from having damaging effects on the body.

Personal hygiene (cleanliness) and sanitation (public cleanliness involving community efforts) both help to prevent diseases. If we will do not take care of our bodies, and the environment in which we live, the body can be infected by germs which will cause illnesses. Avoid direct or indirect contacts with people or objects for diseases like ringworm, scabies. Chicken pox, measles, boils and septic wounds, whooping cough, tuberculosis, and influenza. The food we eat must be well cooked and the water we drink must be clean or boiled so that we do not suffer from food poisoning, typhoid, dysentery and cholera. Always wash your hands and keep them clean.

To be healthy, we should endeavour to keep ourselves clean by wearing appropriate clothes and paying attention to basic roles of hygiene and sanitation. We should vaccinate or immunize ourselves against common infections like polio, yellow fever, meningitis, whooping cough, tetanus and tuberculosis. We should eat a balanced diet, do regular exercises, have enough rest and drink plenty of water to keep your kidney in healthy conditions. We should also have regular medical checks in recognised health centres and hospitals and keep your teeth clean by brushing them regularly with a good tooth paste and a little salt. We should wear suitable shoes and not those that are too tight or too large for us. Equally we should get rid of all waste products (e.g. sweat) from the body by keeping the bowels free. Avoid alcohol, drugs, and cigarette smoking. These cause stomach ulcers, affects lives, the brain, the lungs and leads to premature death.

With our environment, we should properly manage waste materials, dispose of garbage properly and not litter the environment with non-biodegradable materials. Standing pools of water around our homes should be drained, refuse to dumped in dust bins, grass around us cleaned. We should take care of ourselves for prevention is better than cure they say


