The Bakwer were warriors who participated in the slave trade. There were often wars between Bakweri villages. But after the war they tried to resolve their conflicts. They did this in different ways. Villages formed alliances with one another. This helped to unify the Bakweri and it also helped to protect them against colonial intrusions. Mixed-marriage between members of warring parties was also promoted. This taught people tolerance and led to reconciliation. Sometimes a third party was called to mediate in the conflict. Mediation forced people to listen to and accept one another. Revenge was forbidden after a conflict. This prevent conflicts from starting up again. The Bakweri became a peaceful people thanks to unity, tolerance and living together. They could share a variety of traditional meals like cassava; water fufu and eru; fufu corn and vegetables; achu; pepper soup and yams. During traditional manifestations such as the Yam festival and fishing competition, they could celebrate their togetherness and customs. We could see tolerance and acceptance in their lifestyle.
