

SECTION C: READING COMPREHENSION (10 MARKS)

Read the text below about Cameroon diversity and answer the questions that follow .

The name of the country derives from the term used for the Wouri River by Portuguese explorers. Reaching the Cameroon coast near the modern port city of Douala around 1472, those explorers named the river Rio dos Camaroes ("River of Prawns") after the variety of crayfish they found there. This name later was applied to the coastal area between Mount Cameroon and Rio Muni.

Cameroon has distinct regional cultural, religious, and traditions as well as ethnic variety. The cultural • diversity of the country can be seen in the variety of traditional dishes including okok, eru, ndole, mbongo tchobi, folere...as well as the variety of traditional festivals including ngondo, nguon, cocoyam festival.

French and English are the official languages and there are approximately two hundred fifty local languages including Ewondo, Duala, ngemba, ghomala, and Fulfulde. Among the less educated, the Wes Cos dialect of Pidgin English functions as a lingua franca in the English-speaking area and in many neighborhoods in Douala. Both French and English are taught in school, but only those with a secondary education are fluent in both. Most people speak at least one local language and one official language, and many people are multilingual.

There are five national symbols: The flag has three equal vertical stripes of green, red, and yellow, with a golden star in the center of the red stripe. The green colour stands for the rain forest, red for the blood of our ancestors and yellow for the sands of the sunshine while the star stands for unity. The national anthem begins with the words "Oh, Cameroon, thou cradle of our fathers", reflecting the importance of ancestors and kinship and the desire to forge an imagined community with a common ancestry. The feeling of national unity is stronger among school children as there is no discrimination in schools.
