

The family started vomiting immediately. Their neighbour drove them to hospital, where they were treated for poisoning. The head of the emergency unit,  $\[mathbb{D}\]$ r. Aboya, said...." thankfully no one has suffered permanent harm. But consuming rat poison can lead to serious injury or even death. People need to be very careful, and read all food packaging very carefully.
