Social and economic problem linked to alcohol abuse

Drinking too much alcohol is habit with serious consequences. It affects your family life, your behavior and your pocket, your health.

EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL ABUSE

Excessive alcohol consumption can have negative effects on the person drinking, people around them, and community in which they live. Alcohol abuse affects not only the consumer's health but also their performance and wages and their family and economic lives.

Drinking too much alcohol is too bad for people health. People who drink too much alcohol experience

Alcohol consumption can affect work performance. In many companies, people who drink a lot are more likely to take sick leave than other employees. They are also more likely to provoke accidents at the workplace. Other workers perceive that heavy drinkers have lower performance, problems in personal relationships and lack of self-direction. They may eventually lose their job.

Alcohol can also affect family life. Drinking can impact how a person performs as a parent, a partner as well as how they contribute to the functioning of the household. It can have lasting effects on their partner and children, for instance through home accidents and violence. If a woman drinks during pregnancy, her unborn baby can be affected negatively. After birth, parental drinking can lead to child abuse and numerous other impacts on the child's social, psychological and economic environment. Other consequences of drinking on family can include substantial mental health problems for other family members, such as anxiety, fear and depression. Drinking outside the home can mean less time spent at home with the children.

Furthermore, there may be financial consequences in drinking too much alcohol. In fact, apart from money spent on drinks, heavy drinkers may suffer other economic problems such as lower wages and loss of employment opportunities, increased medical expenses, and decreased eligibility for loans.
