RENEWABLE AND NON-RENEWABLE RESOURCE

Water

Although water is a precious resource, it is also the most abused and wasted natural resource. In many Countries, people do not have clean drinking water. We need to use water carefully and in moderation.

Metals

Aluminum can be recycled easily, which saves money, energy and manpower. Steel can be recycled completely.

Glass

Glass can be recycled again. Recycled glass is called Cullet.

Forests

One hundred acres of trees are cut down per minute to produce papers, but human use paper and throw it away without much thought! Did you know that it takes 15-20 years to grow a tree, but less than 10 minutes to fell it? One tree can yield about 700 paper grocery bags, which is how many bags are used by one supermarket in an hour.

Plastic

Every hour, 250 000 plastic bottles are dumped into the environment. 50 per cent of recyclable waste us made up of plastic bottles. The average time needs for a plastic bottle to decompose in a landfill is 700 years. Plastic bottles that are dumped into the sea kill approximately one million sea creatures per year.
