est major cause of delinquency seems to focus on family relationships especially those between parents and lual children. Many studies have shown that if children have had an unhappy home, and if they have fel

iscontented with their circumstances and environment, then delinquency has appeared to them to be a solut he children do not get along with their parents, or if the patterns of discipline and punishment are inconsistent lelinquency seems to bring the attention and approval they crave.

The next cause of delinquency has been stressed by sociologists. It has been seen that if children grow up in a poverty, they are exposed to many more broken homes, a higher rate of alcoholism, poorer schools, unemploy ewer recreational facilities and higher crime rates.

For children in such circumstances, delinquency seems to be an escape from boredom, poverty and other proble social scientists have studied the influence of other youngsters on those who commit delinquent crimes.
