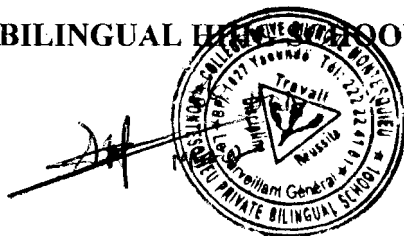

SECTION C

READING COMPREHENSION 10MKS:

In the North-Est corner of Cameroon, at the Minawao refugee camp for people from Nigeria, there is a story of hope amidst the problems.

According to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, approximately 56 000 people live there. They have fled from violence caused by Boko Haram in their home country. They are grateful for the safety and refuge they have found in Cameroon. But one problem was that the sandy soil quickly became completely stripped of vegetation. The refugee camp began in 2013, and as grown steadily since then. As the settlement grew, the trees disappeared. This led to hot condition with no natural shade. And the dust became a problem. It was a depressing environment.

A total of 50 000 trees had been planted by early 2019. That is almost one tree per inhabitant! The trees species include acacia, moringa, neem and Leucaena. The trees species were chosen because they were suited to the dry conditions, and because they grow quickly. They are plans to add fruit trees later, once the soil has been stabilised by first planting of trees.

Initially people had thought they would only be in Cameroon for a few months. They pulled up the trees for two reasons: to make space for tents and temporary shelters, and to have firewood to burn for cooking and for heat.

The environment was already struggling for two reasons: agricultural practices that encouraged deforestation in order to plant agricultural crops, and rising temperatures caused by global warming.

The United Nations High Commission for Refugees, which runs the camps, says the trees benefit both the refugees in the camp now, and the host nation in years to come, when the refugees will have been able to return to their home country. The benefits include a greener environment, with soil stabilisation.
