Indeed, many are those newspaper publishes that were forced to close because they were not able to manage the large quantity of employers with regard to the limited resources the newspaper brings in. many newspaper editors and designers are forced to work with many months of unpaid salary; a situation which seriously impacts on the quality of their output.

The fact that many people rely on social media to get updated about the latest has become a serious problem as the phenomenon of fake news is spreading like wild fire. Newspapers are more quality centric and thus are more reliable over providing current news. The information found in newspapers; unlike that found on social media, is verified before it is published and the source is always mentioned/ information got from social media is not always verified and lack reliable sources.
