2. Discuss the view that the evangelization and educational activities of the London Baptist Missionary Society in Cameroon were carried out with a lot of difficulties. (25 marks)
3. Assess the impact of the introduction of plantation agriculture in Cameroon during German rule. (25 marks)
4. Account for the early successes and subsequent defeat of Germany in Cameroon during the First World War. (25 marks)

### SECTION B: 1922 –1961

5. French economic exploitation of Cameroon during the Mandate contributed to indigenous revolts with profound consequences. Discuss. (25 marks)
6. How far was the move towards political consciousness in British Southern Cameroons influenced by external factors? (25 marks)
7. Examine the impact of the Eastern Nigerian Crisis of 1953 on the independence struggle in Southern Cameroons. (25 marks)
8. What factors led to Ahidjo’s rise to power in French Cameroon and how did he attain the independence of the territory by 1960? (25 marks)

### SECTION C: 1961 TO PRESENT

9. How and why was the CNU created in Cameroon in 1966? (25 marks)
10. Examine the sources of conflict and the impact of the KNDP Crisis on the state of West Cameroon. (25 marks)
11. Evaluate the efforts of Ahmadou Ahidjo in fostering economic development in Cameroon between 1961 and 1982. (25 marks)
12. Under what circumstances and for what reasons was multi-party politics reintroduced in Cameroon in 1990? (25 marks)
