Explanation of Answers

Part I: Fill in the blanks

3. **Had studied** is the past perfect tense, indicating an action that was completed before another past action.
4. **Has given** is the present perfect tense, indicating an action that was completed recently.
5. **Was doing** and **were playing** are the past continuous tense, indicating actions that were ongoing at the same time in the past.
