Cigarette smoking is an important cause of many dangerous diseases. Many reports have associated cigarette smoking to heart diseases, cancers of the lungs, mouth, and other tissues; and other diseases. Cigars and pipe smoking also cause cancers of the mouth.

Those who smoke cigarettes give varied reasons for not giving up smoking. But those who do not smoke claim their right to pure and unpolluted air. Statistics prove that 20% of non-smokers who live in the environment of smokers end up contracting lung diseases just like smokers. This is the cause of the conflict between the two groups. No doubt, non-smoking areas exist in public places in many industrialised countries and this is certainly an example to imitate. After all, no one has the right to suffocate others, especially in public places. Smokers have the obligation to spare others the trouble of inhaling nicotine and other dangerous substances that they puff out from cigarettes. Even in some hotels where strict rules exist for observing "smoking and non-smoking floors", air circulates from one floor to the other.
