## **SECTION D: COMPOSITION (10 marks)**

### **Topic 1: The Strive for Excellence**

Excellence is the quality of being outstanding or extremely good in a particular field or activity. In my society, the person I consider to be excellent is my teacher, Mr. John. He is dedicated, knowledgeable, and always goes the extra mile to ensure his students succeed. Three qualities that make him excellent are his patience, his ability to explain complex concepts simply, and his commitment to continuous learning.

As a student, to achieve excellence, I need to:

- 3) Maintain a positive attitude and persevere even when faced with challenges.

### **Topic 2: Gender Inequality**

Gender inequality refers to the unequal treatment or perceptions of individuals based on their gender. In my community, women and girls often face discrimination in education, employment, and decision-making roles. Three instances of gender inequality in my community are:

- 1) Girls are often discouraged from pursuing STEM subjects.
- 2) Women are paid less than men for the same work.
- 3) Women are underrepresented in leadership positions.

Three disadvantages of gender inequality are:

- 1) It limits the potential of half the population.
- 2) It perpetuates poverty and economic instability.
- 3) It leads to social injustice and unrest.

Three advantages of gender equality are:

- 1) It promotes economic growth and development.
- 2) It leads to a more just and fair society.
- 3) It allows for diverse perspectives and innovation.

The government is working to end gender inequality by implementing policies that promote equal opportunities in education and employment. Additionally, awareness campaigns are being conducted to change societal attitudes. I

believe that more can be done by enforcing stricter laws against gender-based discrimination and providing more support for women in leadership roles.

### **Topic 3: Deadly Disease**

One deadly disease that has killed many people worldwide is **Malaria**. Malaria originated in tropical regions and is caused by the Plasmodium parasite, which is transmitted through the bites of infected mosquitoes. Two causes of the disease are:

- 1) Poor sanitation and stagnant water, which provide breeding grounds for mosquitoes.
- 2) Lack of access to preventive measures like mosquito nets and insecticides.

Two symptoms of malaria are:

- 1) High fever and chills.
- 2) Severe headache and vomiting.

Two consequences of malaria are:

- 1) It can lead to severe anemia and organ failure.
- 2) It causes significant economic burden due to healthcare costs and loss of productivity.

To prevent malaria, governments and communities should:

- 1) Promote the use of insecticide-treated mosquito nets.
- 2) Conduct regular fumigation and eliminate stagnant water sources.
