Our national colours and Anthem

The Cameroun national flag was adopted on May 20, 1975 after Cameroon became a unitary state .Its colours are: green, red and yellow with a star in the middle .The green colour stand for hope and the southern savannah. The star in the middle stand for hope and the southern forests. The red stand for the martyrs' blood and for the unity of the country .The yellow colour stands for the sun and the northern Savannah. The star in the middle stands for unity in the country.

All Cameroonians are called to respect the flag of the country wherever they are because it is a symbol of national identity; it is the Cameroon's pride, a symbol of the country's history. The Cameroon national flag inspires and reminds us of the greatness of our country. It is used at both national and international ceremonies and events (world Cup, Olympic Games, 11th February, 20th May, etc...)

A national anthem is a patriotically musical composition; usually in a poem of a song or hymn of praise that evokes and eulogizes the dreams and inspired the struggle of a nation; the history, customs and tradition of a people. Unlike many countries, Cameroon has a very rich and interesting national anthem, also known as the "Rallying song"(BREAKTHROUGH 5eme p95)
