Diabetes is a major cause of blindness, kidney failure, heart attacks and other heart diseases, stroke and lower limb amputations. There are different types of diabetes namely: type 1, type 2 and gestational diabetes. Type 1 diabetes is usually genetic. If other people in your family have the disease, you may get it as well. Symptoms are: thirst, frequent urination, hunger, fatigue, blurred vision.

Type 2 diabetes often starts in adulthood and is associated with obesity and life style. The symptoms are as same as for type 1 diabetes. Gestational diabetes occurs during pregnancy (gestation). It can affect the mother's and baby's health. It often disappears after the baby is born. Testing during pregnancy is very important.

Diabetes is a disease for which there is no cure. However, diabetes can be controlled by: eating more healthily, exercising and losing weight. Some people also need medication (insulin) to control their diabetes. The disease needs regular monitoring (checking). Balanced meals are important for people with diabetes. They need to avoid sugar and eat proteins and lots of fresh vegetables every day. They can also eat some fruits.
