<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handle with care, • Dust with a dry and soft cloth or brush or feather duster every few months • Frame it with UV-protective glass to shield from light damage, and ensure the painting does not touch the glass. • Keep away from direct sunlight, • Keep away from humid areas, • Store in a dry and cool place, • Keep it upright and not stacked flat • Wrap with acid-free tissue or bubble wrap for protection when transporting. • Handle with dry and clean hands, or wear cotton gloves to avoid oils from your skin • Never use water or cleaning solutions directly on the painting • If there are stains, lightly dab with a damp cloth (distilled water) but test on a small area first. • Always support both the top and bottom when moving it, to prevent bending. • Regularly inspect for signs of wear, mold , or insect damage • If you noticed problems, seek professional restoration • 	<p><i>1mkx1=1mk</i></p>	<p>Accept any one amongst the proposals</p>
