SECTION C: READING COMPREHENSION (10 MARKS)

Read the passage below carefully and answer the questions that follow it. Use your own words.

Garbage is the waste material that we throw away every day. It can be anything from food scraps, paper, plastic, metal, glass, to electronic devices. Garbage can cause many problems for the environment and human health if it is not disposed of properly. Some garbage can pollute the air, water, and soil, while some can attract pests and diseases. Therefore, it is important to collect and recycle garbage in a responsible way.

One way to collect garbage is to separate into different categories according to its type and potential use. For example, we can divide garbage into organic, recyclable, and non-recyclable materials. Organic materials are those that can decompose naturally, such as food scraps, leaves and grass clippings. Recyclable materials are those that can be processed and turned into new products, such as paper, plastic, metal, and glass. Non-recyclable materials are those that cannot be reused or recycled, such as batteries, light bulbs, and medical waste. Another way to collect garbage is to use appropriate containers and bags for each category of garbage. For example, we can use green bins or composts for organic materials, blue bins or bags for recyclable materials, and black bins or bags for non-recyclable materials. We should also label the containers and bags clearly with the

type of garbage they contain. This way, we can make it easier for the garbage collectors to sort out and transport the garbage to the right facilities.

One way to recycle garbage is to reduce the amount of garbage we produce in the first place. For example, we can use reusable items instead of disposable ones, such as cloth bags instead of plastic bags, water bottles instead of plastic cups, and plates instead of paper napkins. We can also buy products that have less packaging or use recycled materials. We can also donate or sell items that we no longer need or want, such as clothes, books, and toys.

Another way to recycle garbage is to reuse the materials that we have already used. For example, we can use old newspapers or magazines to wrap gifts, make crafts. We can also use empty jars or bottles to store food, liquids, or other items.

A third way to recycle garbage is to send the materials that we cannot reduce or reuse to recycling centres or facilities. There, the materials are sorted, cleaned, and processed into new products. For example, paper is shredded, pulped, and dried into new paper; plastic is melted, moulded, and cooled into new plastic; metal is melted, cast, and shaped into new metal, and glass is crushed melted, and blown into new glass. By collecting and recycling garbage in these ways, we can help protect the environment and human health from the negative effects of garbage. We can also save natural resources, energy, and money by reducing the need for raw materials and landfill space.
