Where to stay in Cameroon!

Cameroon is one of the most beautiful countries in Africa. With its cultural diversity and its tourist assets, Cameroon offers a wide range of permanent or seasonal accommodation. From urban to rural areas, you will discover the wealth of this nation. Almost everybody has a place to live.

In big cities like Yaoundé, Douala, Bafoussam and Garoua, most people live in residential areas, villas and apartments. These houses are built with modern materials such as cement, blocks, iron and stones. Most people pay a lot of money to rent houses because it take a lot to build a house in urban areas. The more luxurious the house is, the more money you pay for it. Equally, almost all plots are sold and are very expensive nowadays.

In suburban and rural areas, people dwell in traditional houses made of local materials such as wood, bricks, clay, and straw. All these materials are found in the neighbourhood, so they do not pay for it. Statistics show that 90% of inhabitants of rural areas own a house.

Cameroon also offers good accommodation to local travellers in every town. Luxury hotels, business calls and standard hotels are found in cities and are in heavy demand. It is advisable to book in advance. Mid-range and cheap hotels include guesthouses, hostels, buckaroos and campements are found in smaller towns. They are cheaper but can be noisy and uncomfortable.
